



# Code of Conduct

## **Mission Statement**

The mission of the Classic Jet Aircraft Association is to assist in the preservation of the right to fly our aircraft with the least amount of regulation and restrictions commensurate with their safe operation.

In order to do this, CJAA will interact regularly with the appropriate government agencies at every level, as well as other flying organizations and the general public, to ensure that our voice is heard and that we are included in any process that might affect our ability to fly our aircraft.

CJAA will demonstrate our commitment to the safe and professional operation of our aircraft by the continuous development of safety, training, maintenance programs and publications for dissemination to the members of CJAA.

Recognizing the desire of our members to interact with one another on a regular basis, CJAA will sponsor and/or participate in periodic meetings, fly-ins, air shows, and air racing events where members can socialize with one another and the general public in order to project a positive image of our organization and members to these communities.

In order to achieve our Mission, the Classic Jet Aircraft Association and its members must accept the responsibility to conduct themselves in the most professional and ethical manner as described below.

## **We pledge to develop and maintain:**

- An environment that promotes excellence and professionalism, rather than minimum standards
- Conservative practices, personal minimums and a safety mindset
- Opportunities for members to experience challenging scenarios in a controlled learning environment
- Tools for risk management, and aeronautical decision making, with safety as the highest priority
- Adherence to regulations, limitations and rules of basic common sense
- Personal conduct to demonstrate and promote:
  - Integrity
  - Positive attitudes
  - Personal responsibility and accountability
  - Courtesy toward fellow members of the aviation community
- A commitment to continuing education and personal improvement, including recurrent training
- A system for mentoring of all levels of classic jet aviators
- Respect for the privilege of flight
- Dedication to the safety of all flight operations and the reduction of aviation accidents

Should any CJAA member intentionally and repeatedly disregard this code of conduct, they will be subject to corrective actions from CJAA which may include suspension or revocation of membership in the association.
